Article 01: 2018-19 District Operating Budget

Shall the Rye School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$14,000,230 (Fourteen Million Two Hundred Thirty Dollars) ? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$13,869,687 (Thirteen Million Eight Hundred Sixty Nine Thousand, Six Hundred Eighty Seven Dollars), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Rye School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (Majority vote required.) (NOTE: This warrant article [operating budget] does not include appropriations in ANY other warrant article.)

The Rye School Board recommends the operating budget. (Vote 5 - 0)

The Rye Budget Committee recommends the operating budget. (Vote 10 - 1)

Passage requires a 3/5 majority ballot vote.





